QUALIFIER ONLY – NO AWARDS

Must have completed the basic course training in their home county for shotgun disciplines

TRAP & SKEET: Current ATA and Kansas State Match Rules

- To participate, shooter must be 4-H age 10-18.
- Eye and ear protection required, NO open toe shoes, including Crocs.
- **New shells only, No Reloads** – provide your own shotgun and ammunition not exceed 2-3/4 inch, 3 dram, 1-1/8 oz shot, 7-1/2 shot
- All shotguns will be approved by the Range Officer.
- Trap – 16 yards, 50 targets ** Score 35 to qualify
- Skeet – 50 targets**Score 30 to qualify
- Qualifying in Trap or Skeet will qualify the shooter for Sporting Clays
- No Concessions on site
